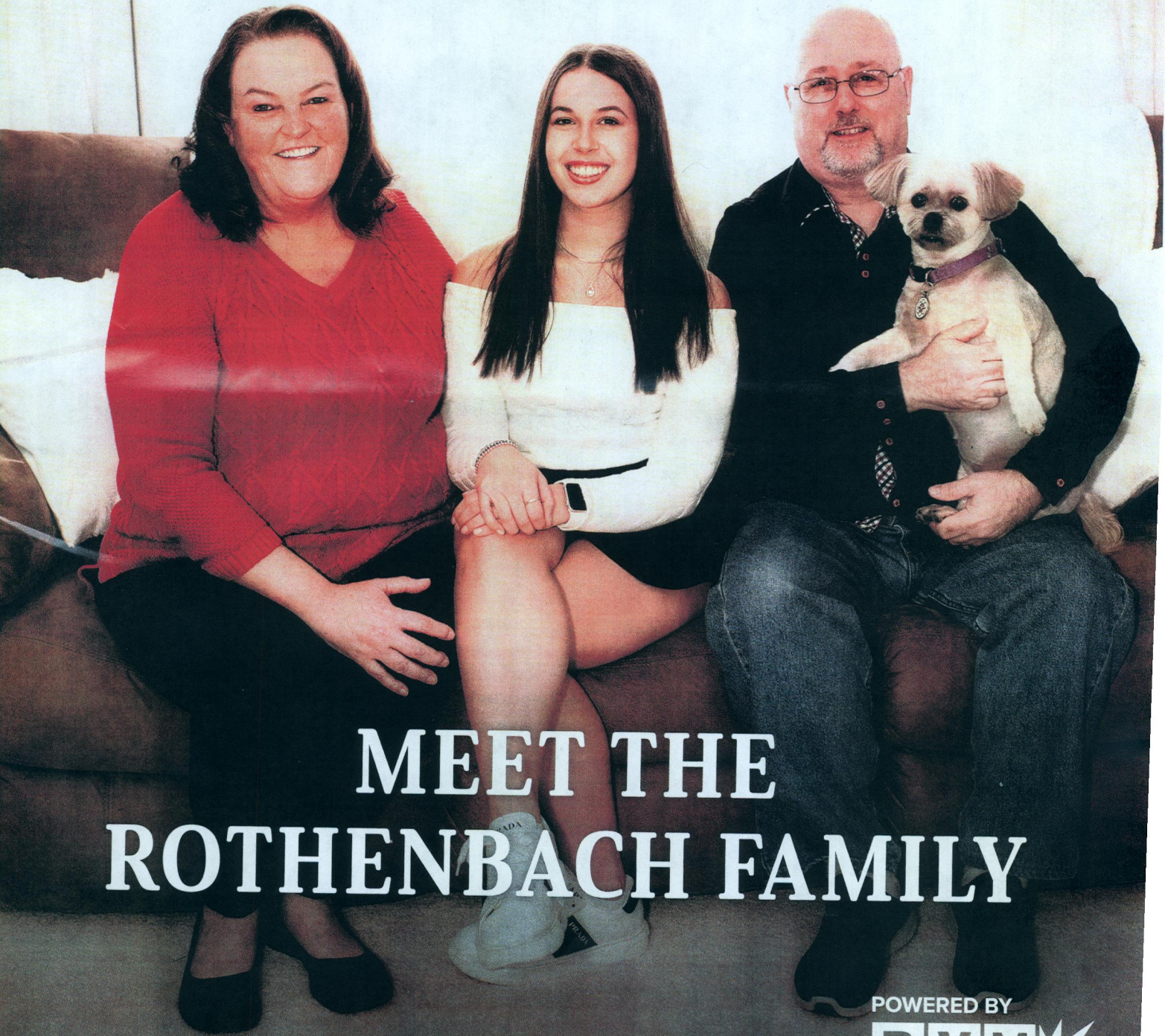

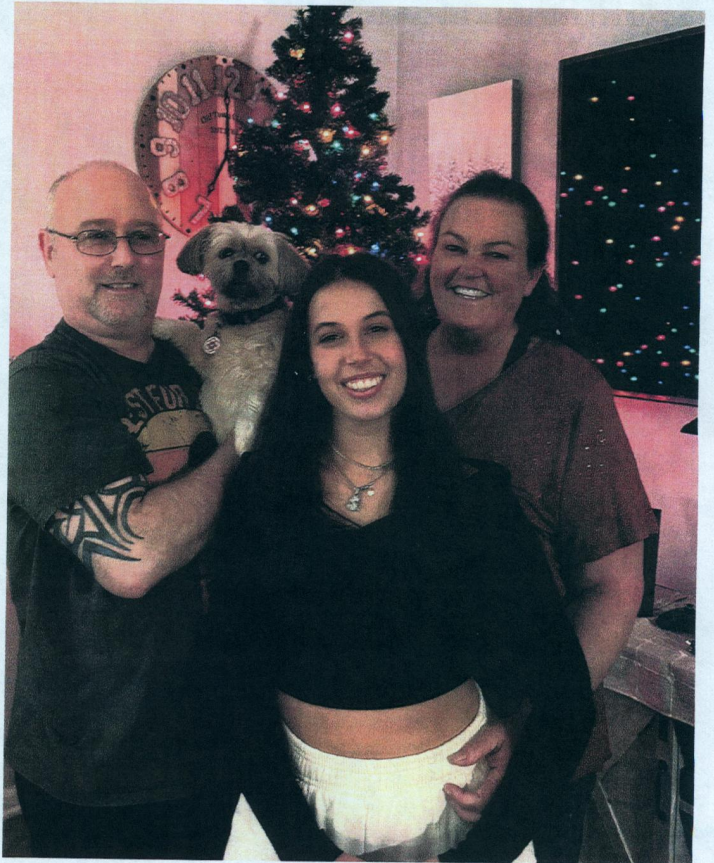
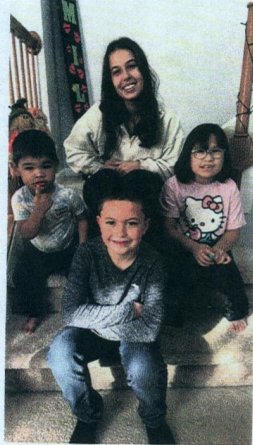
A Sense of Community
